Music Curriculum Intent

At Fairchildes, our intention for our music curriculum is that children take part in a range of musical experiences that enrich their lives and offer them opportunities to become more musical. Included in our provision is the intention that all children will learn about a varied range of music and celebrate diversity through their musical learning. We also intend to develop our learners' understanding of the dimensions of music such as pulse, pitch, rhythm etc and to experience these practically to cultivate their understanding. They will also have the opportunity to play instruments and find the joy and personal progression music can bring. Our intent is to provide possibilities for children to have the chance to take part as an orchestra in collective music making in our steel band and through class keyboard performance. Additionally, we want to support our learners beyond their time with us to pursue music further should they wish to through additional musical opportunities, such as taking part in the Notting Hill Carnival Steel Pan contest 'Panorama' or joining Croydon Steel Orchestra as they enter key stage 3 and beyond.

At Fairchildes, a key part of our intention for our music curriculum is to engage all children in singing. From the beginning to the end of our learner's time at Fairchildes we sing and our children love to take part. Every single week we sing collectively as key stage 1 and 2 together. The well-being aspect of music that singing brings is so important at Fairchildes. Singing individually as a soloist is encouraged and occurs across the key stages at various events. Our intention is that our children see their potential and have the confidence and desire to take a chance and take part.

We intend that everyone is valued and should feel through their Fairchildes musical journey that they can become more musical in an inclusive space. We also intend to show our learners that through practice and consolidation they can reach their potential.

Finally, our intention is that our learners are given the opportunity to perform vocally and instrumentally and see themselves as music makers.
