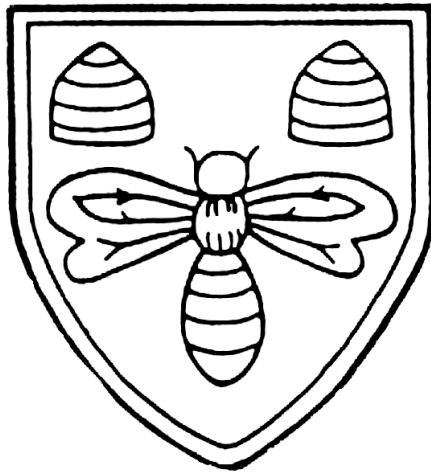

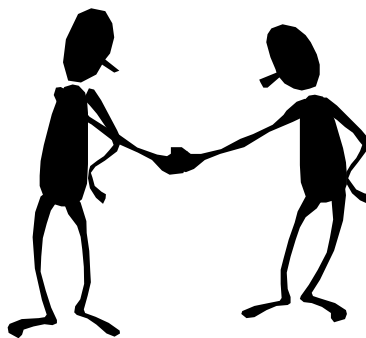
I will make every effort to:-

As a family we will make every effort to:-

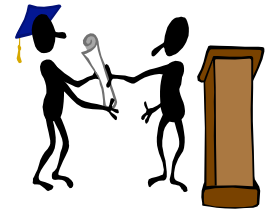
- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and on time.
