

## Uniform Policy for children in Reception to Year 6

<p><b>Girls – Winter Uniform</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dark grey or black skirt, pinafore or school trousers.</li> <li>• White shirt, blouse or polo-shirt.</li> <li>• *Blue school sweatshirt or cardigan, with school logo.</li> <li>• White, grey, navy blue or black socks or tights.</li> </ul> <p><b>Not allowed: Leggings</b></p> <p><b>Girls – Summer Uniform (optional alternative)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Blue and white checked dress or culotte style dress.</li> <li>• Dark grey or black tailored school shorts.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Boys – Winter Uniform</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dark grey or black school trousers.</li> <li>• White shirt or polo-shirt.</li> <li>• *Blue school sweatshirt, with school logo.</li> <li>• Grey, navy blue or black socks.</li> </ul> <p><b>Boys – Summer Uniform (optional alternative)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dark grey or black tailored school shorts.</li> </ul>
<p><b>P.E. Kit</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A plain red t-shirt or polo-shirt (*there is also a plain red t-shirt with the school logo available).</li> <li>• Black or navy-blue shorts.</li> <li>• Black or navy blue jogging trousers (girls are also allowed to wear leggings).</li> <li>• A pair of trainers or plimsolls</li> <li>• The P.E. kit should be kept in a P.E. bag.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Footwear</b></p> <p>Plain black school shoes or plain black trainers, which don't have any logos or any other colour on them.</p> <p><b>Not allowed: Shoes with a sling back, peep toes, high heels or boots.</b></p>	
<p><b>Coats</b></p> <p>Coats should be worn in in cold/wet weather.</p>	
<p><b>Bags</b></p> <p>Children should bring a bag to school to carry things between home and school, e.g. their reading book.</p>	
<p><b>Jewellery</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If a child has a pierced ear/s, they may wear one plain gold or silver stud per ear.</li> </ul> <p><b>Not allowed: Rings, necklaces or bracelets.</b></p>	
<p><b>Hairstyles</b></p> <p>No extreme hair styles are allowed. If a child's hair is longer than shoulder length, it must be tied back. Any hairbands or other hair accessories, e.g. bows, must be plain blue, grey or black and not overly large.</p>	
<p><b>Other</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children are not to wear nail-varnish or fake nails to school.</li> <li>• Please ensure that all items of school uniform are clearly labelled with your child's name.</li> </ul>
