End of Key Stage Results 2021/2022

The information below details the attainment of our pupils with some comparisons with Croydon and National averages. We are delighted with the majority of our results, which show the excellent work of the children, staff and their parents. Any areas for concern in the data (in this case higher achievers and GPS) is used to inform the next year's key academic priorities and the whole school development plan.

EYFS

GLD- A Good Level of Development (GLD) is defined as children working at, or exceeding, the expected standard in the key areas of literacy, maths, physical development, communication and language and personal, social and emotional development. At the end of 2022 62% of pupils leaving Reception had achieved GLD.

Phonics screening

The phonics screening test is completed in Year One. At the end of 2022 66% of Year One pupils passed the phonics test.

Children who do not pass the phonics test in year 1 must retake it in year 2. In 2022, by the end of Year 2 89% of the pupils in that year group had passed the phonics test.

Key Stage 1 Attainment 2022

In year 2 teachers are required to assess each child in the areas of reading, writing, maths and science. National curriculum tests are used to support teacher's judgements in reading and maths.

Key Stage 2 Attainment 2022

In year 6 teachers are required to assess each child in the areas of reading, writing, maths and grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS). National curriculum tests are used to support teacher's judgements in reading, maths and GPS. (Please note that this data remains unvalidated until the end of October, when the DFE sends validated results to schools.)
