

# Year 6 Curriculum Newsletter Autumn 1

Dear Parent/Carer.

Welcome back to another busy year! We hope you have had a restful holiday and are as excited as we are to start a new year. Here is an overview of our learning:

# **English**

Children will learn:

- To identify word classes and use them correctly, e.g. nouns, adverbs, pronouns
- To ensure basic punctuation is used correctly
- To use apostrophes for contractions and possession consistently in their writing.

Our aim is for all children to produce detailed, quality pieces of writing across all the subjects. We will be focusing on writing for a substantial period of time for a variety of purposes.

### Maths

Children will learn to:

- Develop speed and accuracy using written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
- Use knowledge of place value to read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10,000,000
- Round any whole number to a required degree of accuracy

# **Foundation Subjects**

Science: Electricity

- associate the brightness of a lamp or the volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used
- use recognised symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.
- construct simple series circuits, to help them to answer questions about what happens when they try different components, for example, switches, bulbs, buzzers and motors.
