#### Reception


This week in Reception, the children have been following the story We're Going On A Bear Hunt. We have designed and created our own bears and been on a bear number hunt.

We have also been having fun in our Vets! Lots of sharing, turn-taking and lovely telephone manners!




#### Year 5
