### **Introduction**

Fairchildes strives to be creative, innovative and to support our parents/children in the best way possible to make learning purposeful and holistic. Our strategy for remote learning continues this ethos into learning when accessed away from school.

### **Aims and Objectives**

- Ensure consistency in the approach to remote learning for all pupils (Inc. SEND) who aren't in school through use of quality online and offline resources.
- Provide clear expectations for members of the school community with regards to the delivery of high quality interactive remote learning
- Include continuous delivery of the school curriculum

### **Who is the policy applicable to?**

- A child who is isolating when their whole class is at school.
- A child when his/her whole class is not permitted to attend school (e.g. due to medical restrictions or weather circumstances)

### **Content and Tools**

When remote learning is required, it will be delivered and accessed using the following resources:

- Google Classroom
- Use of recorded video for instructional videos and assemblies
- Phone calls home
- Printed learning packs (for those unable to access online learning).

- Physical materials such as story books and writing tools 2
- Use of content websites e.g. BBC Bitesize, LgFL, Mathletics, Times Table Rockstars, Oxford Reading Owls and Oak Academy

## **Home and School Partnership**

Fairchildes Primary School is committed to working in close partnership with families and recognises that each family is unique. Because of this, remote learning will look different for different families in order to suit their individual needs.

Fairchildes Primary School will provide:

- A guide for parents on how to use *Google Classroom*
