Year 1 Summer Term Newsletter.

This term, our topics in Year 1 'Treasure'

As part of our 'Treasure' topic, we will be learning about pirates! We will be looking at famous pirates and finding about what they were like!



In English, we will be learning a variety of texts including 'Beegu' and 'The Pirates Next Door'. We will continue to focus on capital letters and full stops. We will also be thinking about the different ways to join our sentences with conjunctions such as 'because' and 'also' as well as using adjectives to make our writing

more interesting. As always, we will be drafting, editing and redrafting our writing before completing our 'best copy'.

In Maths, we are going to be learning about addition and subtraction (within 20). Place Value (within 50), height and length, mass and volume. Towards the end of the Summer term, we will focus more on multiplication and division, fractions and time. We will, as always, continue with problem solving and reasoning tasks too.

In Science, we are learning about 'Animals, including humans', but this time we will focus on carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will also cover Human Body Parts and Senses before moving on to 'Seasonal Changes' towards the end of the Summer term.



In, Art we are learning about 'Texture' and '3d Sculpture'. This will include using the skills of 'weaving' using paper and card and we will be 'sculpting' using recycled materials.





In Geography we will be learning about maps. We will be describing the location of different features and routes using atlases to help.

In RE, we will be learning about Christianity. We will be investigating what makes Jesus a good friend. We will be learning about and



discussing the importance of religious places of worship. We will also be thinking about the different features of a church and what special things are celebrated in churches.
