## PE:

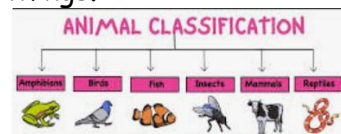

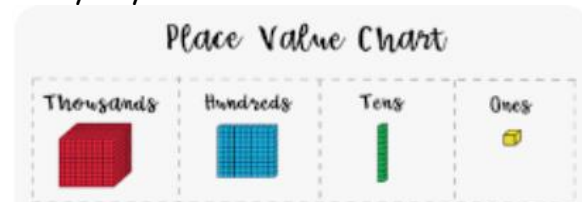
## English
