Susie the snake

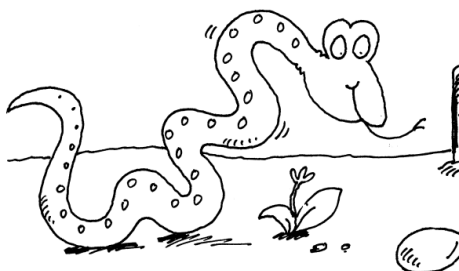
Susie the snake has up to 20 eggs.
